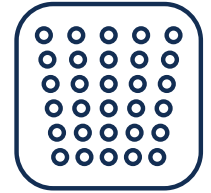


DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY

The silicone, the fabric and the combination of both used for the separating belt was tested in accordance with Recommendation XV Silicones of the German Federal Institute for Risk Assessment and according to the VO EU 10/2011.

The requirements are met if the following temperature and time conditions are not exceeded in the contact with food are not exceeded:

- extractable fractions: 4 hours, 60°C
- volatile organic fractions: 2 hours, 70°C
- Peroxides are not detectable

According to the results of the tests carried out, there are no objections to the use of the material as consumer goods for contact with foodstuffs in the sense of the Foodstuffs and German Food and Feed Code (LFGB) under the above-mentioned contact conditions. The material has been manufactured in accordance with the requirements of Commission Regulation EU 2023/2006 on good manufacturing practice for materials and articles intended to come into contact with food and thus complies with the requirements of the VO EU 1935/2004.
